

School Uniform Sept 2024 - July 2025

The Governing Body of Parrs Wood High School has approved the following school uniform for the academic year 2024/2025 for years 7-11. Parents/Carers should ensure that all items of clothing are labelled with the student's name:

School Uniform

School Blazer (compulsory):

Navy blue School Blazer which must be worn at all times.

School Jumper (optional):

- Black V neck jumper or black Parrs Wood High School jumper with silver trim.
- Round neck jumpers, sweatshirts and hooded tops are not allowed.

School Tie Key Stage 3 students (Year 7-9):

Navy tie with silver over crammed white stripes repeating throughout.

School Tie Key Stage 4 students (Year 10-11):

Silver tie with navy over crammed white stripes repeating throughout.

School Shirt:

Plain white shirt with collar either long sleeve or short sleeve.

School Trousers:

- Black tailored long trousers of polyester / cotton.
- The trousers must be either straight leg or boot cut and must not be stretchy / lycra.
- Cord, canvas, denim trousers, skinny jeans or leggings are not allowed.

School Skirt:

- Black pleated skirt or black Parrs Wood High School skirt with the official school crest embroidered on the left-hand hip.
- Pencil and stretchy skirts are <u>not permitted</u>.

Socks/tights:

- Black or white socks. Socks which rise above the knee are not allowed.
- Plain black tights. Patterned tights and leggings are not allowed.

Shoes (compulsory):

- Black leather, or leather appearance, shoes with low, flat heels are allowed. Where the shoe has laces, there should be two, three or four pairs of eyelets only on each shoe.
- Fashion or heeled ankle boots and knee-high boots are not allowed.





Entirely black trainers or pumps. There should be no obviously visible logos or differentiation in the colour of any aspect of the trainer/pumps including the laces, sole or emblems.

Coats and Bags:

- Coats are not permitted in the building permitted after the red-line.
- Denim, leather or designer coats are unsuitable for school.
- All students must have a school bag which is big enough to hold stationery, planner and 5 A4 exercise books. Handbags and cross-body bags are not allowed.

Jewellery:

- Students may wear a wrist-watch. Smart watches are not allowed.
- Jewellery is not allowed; this includes ear-cuffs, piercings (ear, nose, facial or body), necklaces, bracelets and rings.
- Please do not get your child's ears or nose pierced during term time as they will be asked to remove the piercing and the cost will not be refunded. Plasters covering piercings are not allowed.

Make-up:

- Natural make-up is allowed however, students wearing excessive make-up e.g., eye-shadow, eyelashes that are clearly artificial, cheek contour, lip stick, lip liner or lip-gloss will be asked to remove this.
- Nail varnish is not permitted. Acrylic nails and press-on nails are not allowed; students wearing these will be asked to remove them.

Hair:

- Fashion haircuts and haircuts where there are significant differences between hair lengths within the haircut are not allowed; this includes "Tracks", "Mohawks" or similar.
- Artificial colours are not allowed.

PE Kit (Year 7 to 11)

PE Sweatshirt:

Black sweatshirt embroidered in white with the official school logo on the left-hand chest or a plain black round neck sweatshirt. Hoodies and branded sportswear with large logos are not allowed.

PE T-shirt:

Plain black T-shirt or black T-shirt embroidered in black with the official school logo on the left-hand chest. Fashion and branded sportswear with large logos are not allowed.

Either: Tracksuit Bottoms:

black plain tracksuit bottoms in the winter months for outdoor lessons. Branded sportswear with large logos is not allowed.

(OR): Leggings:

black plain non-cotton leggings. Sports tights with sheer panels are not allowed.

PE Shorts:

Knee-length plain black shorts.





Football Socks:

Plain black football socks.


Trainers:

Sports trainers only; pumps and plimsolls are not allowed.

Football boots:

Please note, these are required for boys' outdoor football and rugby only. Girls' outdoor football and rugby will take place on the Astro-turf and therefore trainers can be used.

Students should not bring personal devices such as smart watches, mobile phones, laptops, i-pods, digital cameras, ear-phones, or any type of mobile technology into school. The school will not be responsible for any such items should they be brought into school and they are lost, damaged or stolen. Students seen in possession of these items will have them confiscated until the end of the day if it is their first offence. Should the item be confiscated for a second time, then a parent/carer will be required to come into school to retrieve the item.



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
