## Parrs Wood High School Uniform Policy September 2023

The Governing Body of Parrs Wood High School has approved the following school uniform for years 7-11.

Parents/Carers should ensure that all items of clothing are labelled with the student's name: school is unable to replace or refund monies for items that are lost, damaged or stolen.

Students should not bring personal devices such as iWatches, mobile phones, laptops, ipods, digital cameras, ear-phones/ear pods, or any type of mobile technology into school. The school will not be responsible for any such items should they be brought into school and they are lost, damaged or stolen.

Students seen in possession of the aforementioned items will have them confiscated until the end of the day if it is their first offence. Should the item be confiscated for a second time then a parent/carer will be required to come into school after 3.05pm on Friday of that week to retrieve that item.

We ask you to ensure that your child adheres to the school uniform regulations.

## Year 7-11 Students

## School Blazer (Compulsory)

- Navy blazer with the official school crest embroidered on left hand chest.
- School Blazers must be worn at all times.


## School Jumper (Optional)

- Black v neck jumper


## School Tie Key Stage 3 students (Compulsory for Year 7-9)

- Navy tie with silver and white stripes


## School Tie Key Stage 4 students (Compulsory for Year 10-11)

- Silver tie with navy and white stripes


## School Shirt (Compulsory)

- Plain white shirt either long sleeve or short sleeve.


## School Trousers or Skirt (Compulsory)

- Black school tailored trousers
- The trousers must be either straight leg or boot cut and must not be stretchy / lycra. The Boot Cut trousers must not be any wider than 25 cm .
- No cord, canvas, denim, skinny jeans or leggings allowed.
- Black school skirt
- No 'tube' or tight-fitting skirts


## Socks/tights (Compulsory)

- Black or white socks. Socks which rise above the knee are not allowed.
- Plain black tights. Patterned tights and leggings are not allowed.


## Shoes (Compulsory)

- All black footwear including all black trainers. The footwear should not have different colours including on the sole/laces.


## Coats

- Expensive designer coats are unsuitable for school. Coats should be worn that can easily fit into a schoolbag.


## Bags (Compulsory)

- All students must have a school bag which is big enough to hold stationery, planner and 6 A4 exercise books.
- No handbags.


## Jewellery

- Students may wear a wrist-watch. iWatches are not allowed.
- Jewellery and piercings are not allowed - this includes earrings and any other piercings (ear, facial or body).
- No necklaces, rings or other jewellery.
- Please do not allow your child to have their ears pierced during term time as they will be asked to remove the piercing.



## Make-up

- No make-up or nail varnish is to be worn.
- No acrylic nails.
- No false eyelashes.


## Hair

- 'Fashion' haircuts and haircuts where there are significant differences
between hair lengths within the haircut are not allowed; this includes
"Tracks", "Mohawks" or similar.
- Artificial colours are not allowed.


## PE Kit (Compulsory)

- PE top - black long or short sleeve
- Tracksuit Bottoms: black plain no logo tracksuit/joggings bottoms or black plain leggings.
- PE Shorts: knee-length plain black shorts.
- Football Socks: plain black football socks.
- Trainers: sports trainers only no pumps.
- Football boots: Please note, these are required for boys' outdoor football and rugby only. Girls' outdoor football and rugby will take place on the astro-turf and therefore trainers can be used.
