•As with any safeguarding allegation, schools should follow their own safeguarding policies and procedures, including informing the LADO should they receive an allegation relating to an incident that happened when an individual or organisation was using their school premises for the purposes of running activities for children.

The Hirer

- Let a member of staff know immediately if you are concerned about your safety and welfare or the safety and welfare of other children.
- Tell a member of staff if you are worried about something.
- If a child in your setting discloses to you that they have been abused or that they feel at risk of harm, you should follow your safeguarding policies and procedures immediately. If a child is at risk of immediate harm, you should call the police on 999. The hirer should also update the Headteacher using the email address above.
